- 2. <u>Presentation and Approval of Minutes</u>. Barry Clarkson indicated that the meeting minutes for the January meeting have been completed as well as the meeting minutes for March. Motion to approve was unanimously approved.
- 3. <u>Waiver Discussion</u>. There are 237 unique owners and we have at least 137 waivers signed. Collins and other members objected to the Waiver and its enforcement. Barry will propose consequences to non-compliance in future meetings.
